Response to an Active Shooter Course

In today's world this has sadly become a reality more than once for large and small departments around the nation and around the world. The fluid dynamics of an Active Shooter are extreme at best. On initiation there is no possibility of planning, no possibility of gathering specialized equipment or resources – the initial immediate response in most cases are the most critical. The nearest armed Law Enforcement Officer is expected to respond with what they have. It is one of the most challenging environments in which a first responder can be called upon to operate. A combination of poor intelligence, mass chaos from bystanders, unknown numbers and lethal force information about the assailants, extremely crowded lines of fire; difficult reinforced approach and the possibility of continued loss of life from the inside are just several of the volatile conditions that make responding a complex task.

Neutralizing the threat or conducting a successful hostage rescue operation requires specific preparation and training; *beforehand*. The more realistic, consistent, and regular training is received, the more rapid and precise an individual will respond with confidence and accuracy; stopping continued loss of life and resolving the violence that could escalate further. **Every patrol officer, school resource officer, and including any officer who carries off duty should have up to date and regular training for the response to an Active Shooter.** This is the one call that if it comes; will affect your community to its core. Train for it, train for it, attend this course and train for it.

In order to succeed, the response and subsequent assault must be executed swiftly with skill and confidence. Using realistic training scenarios, students are taught to strike with surprise and precision in order to minimize casualties. Through the use of innovative simulation using the most advanced technology in the field and scenario drills, we prepare teams to quickly and safely resolve a hostage crisis or active shooter.
